There have been some changes in the CI Champions Committee since we have been away. New members have joined and we have introduced sub-groups to help spread our attention to where it's needed; from training and E-learning to the mentor's network to communications and resources.

Champions Survey What did we find out?

Method

A cross-sectional survey was distributed to 192 registered CI Champions in November 2025; closed January 2026. 69 responses were received (36% response rate).

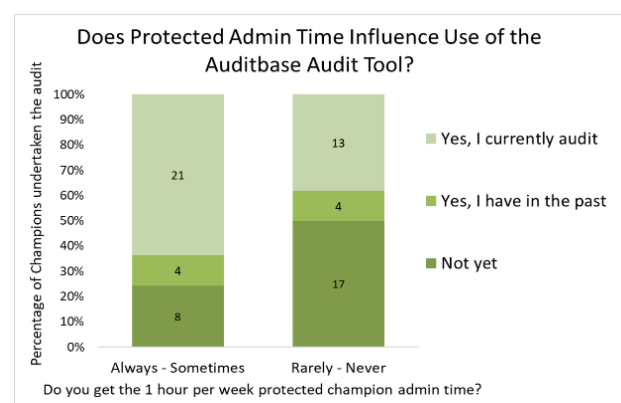
Results

68% of respondents (41/60) rated mentor approachability as 5/5 (Very Approachable).

Receives 1hr Protected Time "Always" (%)	16.4%

Average 1-5, with 1 being not at all; 5 being very.

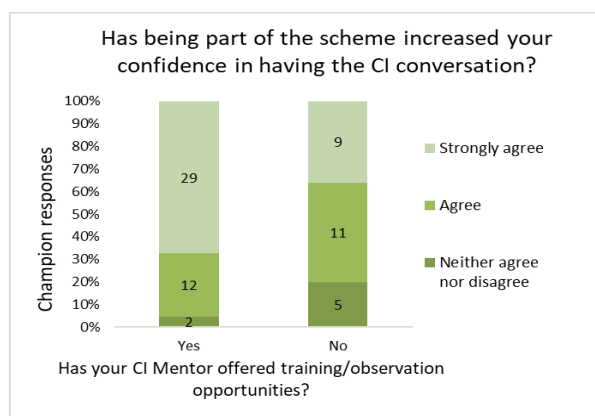
Champions' admin time is most commonly 'Never', with 'Rarely' or 'Never' combined making up 50.8% of responses. Yet the infrequent admin time only mildly impacted the likelihood of auditing – suggesting we have some very motivated champions!



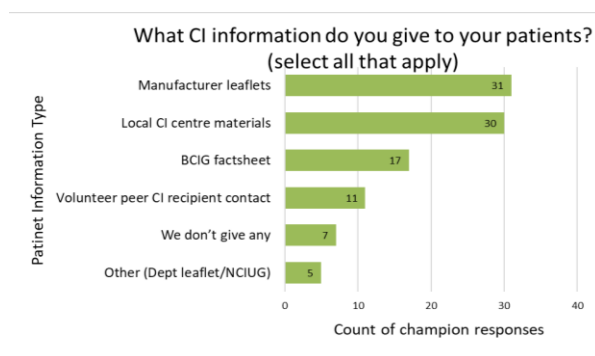
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89.7% of champions agree or strongly agree that being part of the scheme has increased their confidence in having CI conversations. Additionally, being offered training or observation opportunities by CI mentors increased confidence significantly compared to those without observation experience.



The most common resources used are manufacturer leaflets and CI centre materials. Though 13% of respondents report not currently providing any written materials to patients



Conclusion

The CI Champion scheme successfully facilitates approachable mentorship and clinical advocacy. Increased mentor access and protected admin time are the main drivers of clinician confidence within the CI champion's role.
